As you already are aware, it was necessary, after a number of legal maneuvers to plead guilty to the sexual assault matter pending against me.

As a result of this plea, I feel that it is not appropriate for me to hold any position of leadership in the Boy Scouts of America until the mental conditions which led to the commission of the crime have been fully treated by my psychiatrist and psychologist, and I have paid my debt to society.

I hereby resign from any and all positions of leadership which I have held in the George Washington Council B.S.A. I have sent a separate letter of resignation to the Chairman of Varsity Team 117 where I was the Coach.

Please have John Mayer contact me so that arrangements can be made to return my personal property which the district is now using, and for me to turn over to the district that property now in my possession which belongs to the district.

**Admits assaulting girl**

BELVIDERE — Herman C. Meyer Jr., 53, of Columbia, pleaded guilty Tuesday to sexual assault of an 8-year-old girl in Blairstown Township June 15.

Superior Court Judge John F. Kingfield ordered a psychiatric examination at the Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center at Avenel and set April 18 as a tentative date for sentencing.

Under terms of a plea agreement, the Warren County Prosecutor's Office will follow the recommendation of the state diagnostic center for treatment if Meyer's conduct is found to be that of a compulsive and repetitive sex offender. Otherwise, a jail sentence not to exceed five years will be recommended.
