Dear Sirs:

Mr. Ray Fidler, age 20, was registered in the Explorer program at the Kilmer Job Corps Center, Edison, New Jersey, for one month.

We had him terminated due to unnatural sex behavior with other Corpsmen.

At age 13 Ray was referred to the Youth Service Board in Massachusetts. He was sent to the Lyman Home for Boys for nine months.

He returned home for two months and then was sent to Lyman for two more months.

He was then transferred to Bridgewater Home because of homosexual behavior, where he remained for two and one half years.

He was released for three months and then re-committed for unnatural sex acts. He remained at Bridgewater for another two and one half years.

He was discharged at age 19 and entered the Army for three months. He was given a medical discharge from the Army.

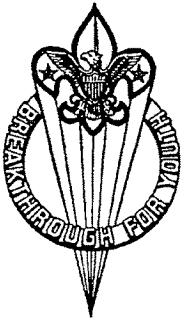
He came into the Job Corps in March of 1968.

We referred Ray to his counselor for psychiatric treatment. Ray refused help through Kilmer and promised to be an out-patient in a clinic in Boston.
