RECOMMENDED FOR CONFIDENTIAL FILE FOR FOLLOWING REASONS:

On 7/24/72 [REDACTED], age 12 of McGuire Air Force Base and his mother formerly complained to the Military Police regarding Schumann performing immoral acts with the [REDACTED] youngster.

Schumann, Scoutmaster of Troop 18, on 7/23/72 had taken a Patrol of Scouts for an overnight stay at a cabin on Brindle Lake which is a part of U.S. Army Post - Fort Dix. While in the cabin that evening with 7 to 8 Boy Scouts, Schumann had the boys strip naked as he himself did. He then hugged the boys and fondled their genitals while he masturbated.

All of the Boy Scouts involved were interviewed by the Law Enforcement officials at Fort Dix. All of the boys implicated Schumann as having performed unnatural sexual acts with them on more than one occasion.

Because this happened on Federal property the FBI at Trenton, N. J. was called in. Special Agent Chelis Patterson investigated. Schumann received disbarment orders from Ft. Dix which prevents him from entering any military installation.

On 10/10/72 Schumann appeared before U.S. Magistrate, John W. Devine and pleaded guilty to the charges.

Schumann had been listed in the B.S.A. Confidential Files - see information attached. On 3/12/71 he was removed from the confidential list.



Relative to yours of February 23, 1971, I met with Robert J. Schumann on February 25th. The meeting was rather extensive and covered his problems in California. I feel that Mr. Schumann suffered from a lack of good judgement and this, coupled to his immaturity, created most of the problems that existed.

I personally cannot find any cause to keep Mr. Schumann from participating in Scouting as a volunteer and recommend that his name be removed from the confidential file.

It is my intent to refer Mr. Schumann to a troop that has a quality Scoutmaster who can help guide him in his own development toward manhood. This is not a precautionary measure. It is merely the application of a philosophy that I have; Scouting can help adults, too.

Your advice will be appreciated.


Before I had an opportunity to check our confidential file, he called back and indicated that he had already talked to you and I should not search any further.


