F. Barry Bossa, well-known in the Burlington area, began new duties Sept. 1 as religious education coordinator for the Malone District School of Religion, Malone, N.Y.

Bossa was graduated cum laude from St. Michael's College in 1971 with a B.A. in history and is completing his thesis for a master's degree in Medieval History at the University of Vermont.

He has worked in liturgy, art and musical composition at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, the DeGoesbriand Unit chapel and the Chapel of St. Michael the Archangel at SMC.

He taught two semesters of the Monte Cassino church music course at St. Stephen's Church in Winooski, where he was choirmaster while attending St. Michael's and UVM.

The son of Mrs. Helen Bossa of Bridgewater, Mass., he attended Stonehill College and Cardinal O'Connell Seminary in Jamaica Plain, Mass., and spent several years with the Benedictine

Monks at Hingham, Mass., Benet Lake, Wis., and Weston.

He will supervise and plan the religious education program for the Catholic high school students of the eight parishes which send students to the public high school of Malone, Franklin Academy. These students attend church school on a released-time arrangement. He also will help train the teachers and be an instructor himself.
